Overton Cricket Club & Overton Recreation Centre - Membership criteria and FAQ's

Overton Cricket Club (OCC) playing facilities are provided by the Overton Recreation Centre (ORC). The cricket club pay the ORC an annual levy for the use of these facilities.

In order to become a member of the cricket club you must also be a member of the ORC. The simplest way of becoming a member of both organisations is to be a 5 Star member of the ORC and make sure that your membership is affiliated to the Cricket Club (thus saving need to pay separate cricket club membership fees). Alternatively you can obtain a basic ORC membership and join the cricket club separately. The options costs are as follows:

- 1. 5 Star Membership (affiliated to OCC = £10 per month or £120 per year with 5 entries into monthly cash prize draw), or
- 2. Basic Membership £24 ORC membership (1 entry into cash prize draw per month) plus £30 cricket club membership = £54.

How do I get 5 Star ORC membership?

Visit http://www.overtonrecreationcentre.org.uk/membership.html and download the form. Make sure that you affiliate to the Cricket club clearly on the form (If you do this then the cricket club receives a £50 annual rebate for your membership and the cricket club will not ask you for any further membership). Cost is £10 per month paid by standing order to the ORC. You will get 5 chances entered into the monthly draw with top prize of £1000 cash!

What if I am an under 18 player for the seniors and/or in full time education? -

'Junior' membership of the cricket club is £35 per year.

What if my parents are members of the ORC already?

If a parent is a 5 Star member of the ORC 'affiliated' to the Cricket club, you don't have to pay a cricket club membership however this is limited to a child per adult. Please note if a parent and child both play for the club then both must be members of the ORC and OCC.

What is 'Basic membership'?

If you don't want to be a 5 Star member of the ORC then you have to be a 'Standard Member' of both the cricket club and the ORC. ORC Standard membership is £24 per annum and gives you a single entry into the monthly prize winning draw (use the link above to obtain details of how to become a standard member) and you also must be a standard member of the Cricket Club for £50 per season payable by 1st June by cheque to Overton Cricket Club. Ian Clark is the Club Treasurer and Henry Deacon holds membership data.

What if I am only likely to play a few times in the season?

We ask that you pay a higher match day fee of £10. If you play more than 3 times in the season then you must become a member of the cricket club and ORC.

What do I get for my membership?

You get to play cricket for the best club in Hampshire!! We play adult cricket at a range of levels from 1st team in County Div 2 all the way down to Sunday friendly matches and mid week T20 league. There is summer training for both adults and juniors and winter nets and indoor cricket. We have a great social and family side to the club and will be running fundraising events which are always good fun.
