	DISCUSSION AND DECISIONS
01/26	<p>To receive representation from the public (10 minutes): Following on from March report, the volunteers are still following the management plan.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. More flowering – bluebells, cowslips, primroses etc replacing the daffs. Trees in blossom. 2. Cut grass to central area and path to top. 3. Mild raised bed work by Alan & Jude, including some solar lights. Michael mentioned that the daffs are dying away now, the trees are in blossom to add more colour, the grass has been cut around the middle to create a natural pathway with long grass left at the sides. The raised beds have been tended and some solar lights added in the corners. KH said it was looking lovely. MY noted that he would set out the path and get the noticeboard done asap.

07/26	<p>Reports from District/County Councillors: Cllr. Melton explained that there was little to report this month, he highlighted the Neighbourhood planning again as being very important to ensure Parish Councils have a say in future development, he will bring more information on the funding available for this to the next meeting. The French Horn application looks like it will be approved under delegated authority, he confirmed that there were insufficient planning grounds to enable him to call it into the Planning Committee for decision. KH did express her disappointment that this 'call in' had not been done when it was first requested. He highlighted the new grant funding opportunities that NSDC had recently opened again. Clerk to get details for the PC.</p>

To accept the latest financial reconciliation as of 31st March 2026: The Parish Council Bank reconciliation was agreed and signed off by the Chairman b. To note payments received and authorise invoices for payment: The payments received were noted and invoices for payment were signed off by two Councillors
11/26	<p>Planning matters 26/00382/PIP Land to the east of Hockerton Road Upton 1-5 Houses. Residents expressed their concerns over this, highlighting the fact it was in the Conservation area, Highway safety concerns, the Nursery mentioned in the letter was in fact the Cricket Club pavilion and therefore this should not be considered an infill application. Hockerton Road was very narrow and used by walkers, cyclists and horse riders, the increase in traffic during construction would be dangerous as there was no formal verge. There was insufficient drainage and the road needs widening. This was debated in full by Councillors who expressed their concerns, a vote was taken (AR) abstained and it was agreed that the Clerk would write in to the Planning department to lodge the Parish Councils objection to the PIP and to reflect the concerns shown by some residents to the application. Cllr. Melton highlighted that a PIP was not a full application and there were limited planning reasons for refusal.</p>
