To partake in the partnership, and receive feedback, you will need a 'My Norfolk Account' for your Parish. Many Parishes already use this system to report defects in their area. If you don't already have an account you can set one up by visiting:

and following the 'Sign in/Register' link.

Once logged in to your account you will be able to report highways defects by clicking on the 'Report a highways problem' link, which is highlighted in blue under the 'Roads and Transport' heading (mid page). This reporting system allows you to pinpoint on a map the exact location and details of the defect you are reporting and, in turn, allows the Rangers to successfully identify the defect upon their visit.


Using your 'My Norfolk Account' will enable the Rangers to track your reports of defects, provide feedback through the stages of your reports and deliver accountable outcomes.
