

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER, LONDON ROAD, STINSFORD

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 10 July 2026 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 24 July 2026. Working times will be between the hours of 5am and 5pm.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out surface dressing works.

The effect of the notice is to impose a temporary speed restriction of 10mph within the working area (as indicated by signs on site), at any point along London Road, Stinsford to facilitate the use of a convoy working vehicle.
