Wilstead Bowls Club Regulations

- 1. The sale and supply of intoxicants will be subject to current licensing laws and the relevant notice clearly displayed in the bar area.
- 2. No betting allowed on the Club premises. Gaming may be allowed subject to current legislation and lotteries may only take place subject to prior written permission of the Management Committee.
- 3. All members must adhere to the Club Regulations and their behaviour at all times must be such as not to bring the club or sport into disrepute.
- 4. Whilst bowling members must obey the Laws of the Sport and any instructions posted by the Green Committee or Management Committee.
- 5. Dress Code for scheduled games as per rules applying for those occasions. Wilstead shirts/blouses to be worn on all occasions when officially representing the Club with Whites or Greys and appropriate Bowls Shoes. Any individual wearing Sandals do so at their own risk. At National level sandals may now only be worn by those holding a Doctor's Certificate.
- 6. Flat soled shoes and tidy casual dress is permissible for roll-ups. For club matches and competitions Grey/white trousers/skirts/tailored shorts with club/white tops.
- 7. Members, other than juniors, may reserve all or part of the Club for a Private Function by returning a completed booking form together with the appropriate fee to the Club Secretary or Booking Secretary at least fourteen days prior to such function.
 - a. Sale and consumption of alcohol at such functions must be in accordance with licensing laws.
 - b. No more than twenty five such functions to be held in any one year.
- 8. Members may entertain guests at the Club providing both sign the Visitors' Book kept for this purpose. The member will be responsible for their guests' conduct and must not leave before their guests. No person whose membership has been terminated or whose application for membership has been rejected will be introduced as a guest.
- 9. Visiting teams, officials and supporters will have full use of facilities subject to regulations and legislation.
- 10. The Management Committee may post Notices necessary for the good order and Management of the Club (eg. Car Parking, Smoking, Steps onto Green, No Running etc.) All members must adhere to these Notices.
- 11. No smoking allowed on the Green, this now includes Electronic Cigarettes. Smoking is permitted off the green and in recognised smoking areas.
- 12. Any member becoming aware of any dangers or defects anywhere on club premises must report the same to a Committee Member as soon as possible in order that it can be rectified.
- 13. System for main keys and club access. A list will be kept of those members holding keys for entry to various parts of the club premises in the course of their duties. No one other than those authorised should hold any of these keys.
- 14. The last person leaving the premises must ensure everywhere is secure and locked.
