This year will be held on Sunday 10th November at York Railway B&SC. Start time 10:30.


As this falls on Remembrance Sunday, we will be observing a 2 minutes silence at 11am.


Let's raise the profile of your club and hopefully the County as a whole by you achieving success in any/all the above competitions, as the saying goes **you have to be in it to win it!**
