#### MEETING OF THE DALES LEAGUE COMMITTEE AT GREENACRES, SNAINTON 2pm 29 SEPTEMBER 2023

1 Attending; Treasurer Peter Mansfield, Colin Burdon, Jim Dawson, Tony Bell, Colin Macdonald, Chairman Ann Vardy, Shirley Wakefield, Secretary Edrene Rumley.

2. Apologies; Mike Anderton, also Tony Corcoran and John Sleightholme who attended for an evening meeting.

3. Treasurer's report; All clubs had paid subscriptions. Peter feels he needs to be replaced due to health grounds, and was thanked for his efforts for the league. All were asked to try to find a replacement for Peter. The Treasurer's role is not arduous; most subs are paid by BACs, and at the end of the season there will be a single session of Kirbymisperton Hall hire to be paid and the bill for trophy engraving. Jim Pewtress kindly arranges the Annual Dinner at Kirkbymoorside Golf Club where they are happy for diners to pay on the night, so the Treasurer is not involved in that. It is important that we all try to find a replacement Treasurer.

4. Discussion item from AGM; Tony Corcoran had suggested that where it was necessary to find a replacement date for a game and 3 dates had been given without success, then the game should be awarded to the host team. In discussion it was felt that teams should be encouraged to co-operate to find dates acceptable to both teams at all costs – first stage each side suggest 3 dates, then if these were unsuitable each suggest another 3, and if agreement had still not been reached then neither side should claim the game or get any points. This will need time so negotiations should not be left too late in the season.

6. It was noted that members who belong to more than one Short Mat Club only need to pay the £4.50 English Short Mat Bowling Association membership once. This has always been the case but dismay was expressed that North Yorkshire Short Mat Bowling Association had previously collected extra payments and kept them rather than informing members that second – or in some cases third – ESMBA subscriptions were not due.

7. ESMBA rule change should be noted by clubs; Velcro on the bottom of fenders is not allowed and should be removed.

8. Due to costs of hall hire all were in agreement that tea breaks should not be re-instated.

9. Members should be reminded that notice needs to be given if a bowl is to be played with weight. Members should be reminded about foot-faulting, where part of the foot is not on or over the mat on delivery.

All were thanked for attending. Next meeting will be the AGM 19 April unless circumstances dictate that an earlier meeting is required.
