## Recommendation

To accept the outcome of the consultation and to enter into a JCT Works and Contractors Design (2016) with Wicksteed Leisure Ltd of Digby Street, Kettering, Northamptonshire NN16 8YJ for the sum of $£ 50,000$ exc VAT.

Any minor changes will be agreed with the Working Group
During the last week a public consultation has taken place with groups across the village to establish the most popular scheme for the playground replacement.

Events were held at Hamble Primary School, with parents, at the Hamble Village Play School and local residents. It was also posted on the website and social media.

The response has been great with 226 responses of which 169 came from children.
The most popular scheme was Wicksteed which was both colourful and had a good range of inclusive equipment.

Of the three shortlisted for consultation, the Wicksteed scheme had a slightly lower score ( 22.5 rather than 23) which reflected the fact that none of the equipment itself reflected the aeronautical or maritime influences (although the surfacing did). It met all the other criteria.

Given it is the clear winner from the consultation and the scoring was very close it is recommended that the Council accepts the tender from Wicksteed for the sum of £50,000.

There are some small tweaks to the scheme that the contractor will be asked to consider such as co-locating all the swings in a single location. Any minor changes that are required will be agreed by the Working Group.

The Working Group would like to record its thanks to all the companies that submitted schemes and also the schools, children and parents for providing feedback and to EBC for the section 106 contributions towards the project.
