The Clerk reported on the Ludlow and Rural Area Parish Plan review meeting to be held in Ludlow on the 21<sup>st</sup> March 2019 to which the Parish Council could send a representative.

The Clerk explained the purpose of the Place Plan which is based on the main Market Town and Neighbouring Parishes and relates to the future infrastructure to support the development of Industry and Housing and some local priority Neighbourhood Schemes which may be partly funded from the Community Infrastructure Levy.

The Clerk explained that the Community Infrastructure Levey was obtained from development of new Marketable Housing within a Parish and 15% of the contribution would be payable direct to the Parish Council each year provided there had been some development within the Parish to help fund local Recreational Capital Schemes, 10% would be for County-Wide Strategic Schemes, 5% for Administration and the remainder for Local Infrastructure Schemes included with the Ludlow and Rural Area Place Plan.

## 9. Highway/Amenity Items:

There was some concern about vehicles parking on the pavement in parts of the village and that consideration should be-given to narrowing the verge along the boundary of the Village Hall Field to provide some additional parking facility, the Clerk will ask Shropshire Council highways for their views.

A quote was still awaited from the Village Hall Committee for the provision of a new Notice Board for consideration by the Parish Council
