
1B - Actions to be taken before a flood: Locations at risk of flooding / source of flooding

Area 1	Old School House	Overland flow down road due to inadequate drainage and lack of maintenance. Stream overflow	See map. Also overflow from stream which bypasses culvert and flows across road on between Old School House and Village Hall when culvert surcharges
Area 2	Wakeham Farm Junction	Overland flow along/across junction due to inadequate engineered drains and lack of maintenance Poorly engineered junction between piped stream and road drainage	See map
Area 3	Hillingsdown Cross	Overland flow due to drains not being able to capture runoff on steep road	Down Hillingsdown and across junction
Area 4	Backshay	Overland flow from Vinyard running down footpath into Backshay due to lack of road drainage.	See map
Area 5	Links Road	Road floods whenever the drainage becomes blocked due to lack of maintenance	Ponding across full width of road
Area 6	Pinhays	Road floods whenever the drainage becomes blocked due to lack of maintenance	Across road
Area 7	Lane End	Road floods whenever the drainage becomes blocked due to lack of maintenance	Ponding across full width of road
Area 8	Sutton telephone exchange	Road floods whenever the drainage becomes blocked due to lack of maintenance	Ponding across road

2B – Actions to be taken during a flood: local volunteers / flood wardens
