Important information about your booking.

Access to the building:

St John's Church and the Laundry building are easy to find:

The church is signposted from the main road (see map).

There is no access for coaches. Please follow the lane to the end and park where the sign says "church". Access to both church and Laundry is through the church gate. There is no access through the farmyard for vehicles. We rely on the goodwill of all the residents of Hall Waberthwaite and ask you to be aware that this is a working farm. If you need to unload heavy material, or have severe mobility needs, please contact Catherine Winzor at cmwinzor@btinternet.com or on 01229717649 or 07807098652 and she will try to help.

The church is always open. Please make sure you switch off the lights on leaving both buildings. The lights in the toilets are controlled by a sensor so will stay on for a while after you leave the building.

We ask you to respect the fact that the churchyard is consecrated ground.

Access to the Laundry building. When you make the booking you will be sent a key code for the main door. The door to the toilets may be unlocked. On leaving, lock the connecting door to the toilets from the middle room and leave the key in the lock. Lock the main door and replace the key in the key box.

Toilets: We have a "trench arch" system of drainage. This means that **nothing** should be flushed in the toilets except soft tissue paper and that no chemicals can be used in toilets, sinks or basins. This is very important, and we ask you to use the disposal bags and bins provided.

Drinking water: All the piped water on site is rainwater. It is treated to make it safe for drinking.
