Minutes of Full Council held on 19th April 2023 at Cerne Abbas Village Hall

There were 9 members of the public present.

As Deputy Chair, Cllr Bolt Chaired the meeting.

The meeting commenced at 9pm.

1. Apologies for absence

Cllr's Prowse, Beresford, Paul, Crosbie, and Horsington sent apologies.

2. Declarations of pecuniary and other interests

Cllr Burghart declared an interest in agenda item 4.

She was granted dispensation to speak but not vote.

3. Public Discussion Period

The Chair allowed public participation in item 4.

There were no other matters.

4. Funding for the Kings Coronation

It was confirmed that two separate bids had been received for funding.

The Clerk confirmed that £500 had been set aside.

Much discussed was had as to what was appropriate public funding and what of the costs 'should' be deemed voluntary such as use of electricity.

The following resolutions were made:

- a. Members agreed that such an occasion as the Kings Coronation must be marked with every child in the school receiving a memorial mug as requested by the school.
The Parish Council would purchase 80 mugs up the cost of £400.00.
Funding to come from the General Reserve.
- b. Members agreed to fund elements of the street party which included speakers, bunting, advertising, and insurance.
The Parish Council would fund up to £462.50, on repayment on production of receipts.
Funding to come from the Kings Coronation Reserve.

5. Payments for authorisation

There were **7** payments (PV's 1-7) totalling **£2667.44** that were approved and authorised for payment.
