## Proposal for Council to organize a Street Party in the High Street Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

**Scope of event:** Street party from one end of the High Street to the other, open to all residents of the parish and their friends / family. Tables will seat 6, and partygoers will bring their own table's decorations, food, drink, cutlery and glasses. Tables will be arranged along the centre of the High Street, pushed together with gaps to allow crossing over at approx. 20m intervals.

**Costs:** The Event is intended to be a non-profit making event but there may some costs involved. Once final details are known there may need to be a payment for attendance. If there is a shortfall, then the NWPC are asked if they will cover this cost. It is proposed that any profit from the Event will be passed on to the Nether Wallop Social Club Charity. A raffle may be organised by the Nether Wallop Social Club at the event.
