We have joined a digital world and much of what we do can now be paperless. Our Member Without Port folio Ken Leamon has provided a 'download' facility on the website. Increasingly you will be able to access forms online and email them to the County without the need for paper copies.

An example of how this is (or isn't) working:

For the 2018 Gen1 return in December last year I clearly asked and specified how the completed forms should be emailed back to me so that I could 'copy and paste' them to the SBA database.

Of 76 Clubs, 11 posted me paper copies – I then had to manually type those in !?!?!
