Mid Devon Wards

Changes recommended by the Local Government Boundary Commission, awaiting Government approval, will mean that Thelbridge Parish Council will be in the Way ward instead of Sandford and Creedy. Nomansland will no longer be split between two Mid Devon District Council wards. The change will take effect with the 2023 District Council elections. This year's elections are for Devon County Council and the Police and Crime Commissioner.
