#### **Barby Keel Animal Sanctuary**

The Sanctuary is now open every Sunday afternoon until the end of October (weather permitting.)

The sanctuary café is open from 2 – 4.30pm where you can buy hot and cold drinks, home made cakes, and other snacks. There is also a small souvenir shop. All proceeds go towards taking care of the animals.

The sanctuary takes care of many animals including cats, pigs, goats, horses, shetland ponies, peacocks, geese, chickens, rabbits and guinea pigs.

Entry to the sanctuary, the car park and optional guided tours are free.

There is a free minibus that picks up from Bexhill Town Hall Square at 1.45pm and at Sidley Car Park at 1.50pm.
