Fallen Tree 30th December 2017

Mr Sales had found the entrance to the woods at Comp Way blocked by a fallen Silver Birch. The tree was cut up and removed from the path. Another Silver Birch that was rotten and leaning dangerously over the path leading into the Beech Glade was also cut down.
