

RINK MARKINGS

SIX RINKS – 5.5 Metres wide



The coloured paint marks on the white edging stones are for setting up to play on six rinks.

These colours are, green, black, blue, red and yellow.

Under normal circumstances these will be changed weekly on a Tuesday morning by the maintenance team.

The purpose of this, is to allow even wear to the playing surface.

The colour in use for the week will be written on the white board on the side of the shed.

If you are playing in a County or S&D match and have a colour preference, it is permissible to change the rinks for the match, but please ensure, either you or the duty steward puts them back to their original positions at the end of play.

SEVEN RINKS – 5.2 Metres wide

If seven rinks are required, the markers should be placed on the green paint marks on the tarmac.

Please return markers to normal weekly position at end of play.

EIGHT RINKS – 4.3 Metres wide

If eight rinks are required, the markers should be placed on the blue paint marks on the tarmac. Please return markers to normal weekly position at end of play.

N.B – The maximum and minimum widths as laid down by Bowls England are, 5.8 and 4.3 metres.
