It has been agreed that Boyton will celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> May. We will hold a Bring and Share Street Tea Party outside Boyton Church Hall. After the tea, there will be a presentation of Coronation memento gifts from Boyton Parish Council to the school children and others who apply.

Then everyone will go to Mr Ellacott's field at the top of Underlane where there will be a Film night for the whole community. There will be a large marquee for the film audience and a separate tent for the bar. We will show a family film for all ages at 5.30. Then we hope to show the big concert taking place at Windsor Castle, broadcast live at 7.30 by the BBC that evening. If this is not possible we may show a second film.

It is hoped that there will be children's games before the Street Tea Party, but we await confirmation from the Boyton Sports Club that the organisers are available to bring their equipment. Otherwise Boyton School PTA will be asked if they wish to organise children's games.

The event will be free to attend for everyone in the parish. There is an application for £4,000 financial support from the Boyton Solar and Wind Farm Community Fund awaiting decision at the Grants Panel meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> March. In the meantime, Boyton Parish Council has been funding working capital for deposits to secure facilities.

This is an interim report. There is a Coronation Event Committee meeting tomorrow night, 14<sup>th</sup> March, when more questions will be answered and decisions taken.
