Correspondence received since last meeting - Noted

A request has been made from Beltingham Church for financial support from the parish towards the grass cutting. The cost for the upkeep last year was- £4494. Members will consider this at the February meeting when they approve grants. However, in the meantime, the clerk was asked to write back and clarify if this was for the new area only or if it included the old churchyard area. Also, to clarify, if the old area is now a closed churchyard or, if it is still open does the family contribute to the costs?

A survey has been received about green spaces in preparation for NCC to being the next local plan. It was agreed to add in a bridleway that is inaccessible. Cllr Gill will send more details to the clerk for completion of the survey.
