

Name/timing of market	Wells Farmers' Market Every Wednesday all year round (9am - 3pm in July and August; 9am – 2.30 pm all other months)
Address and postcode	The Market Place, Wells, BA5 2RB (in front of the Town Hall)

Indoor/outdoor	Canopies provided.
Table provided/needed and space available	Bring your own table – there's room for an L shaped layout. The Farmers' Market is a 17 pitch section of a much bigger general market under the jurisdiction of Mendip District Council (overall manager: Stuart Beeton).
Electricity	Electricity available (£2) but must be requested in advance. Own extension lead needed. Equipment must be PAT tested. Priority is given to chiller cabinets. If cooking keep equipment away from the public on a side table.
Parking information and costs	Unload at the market then if you are early repark free of charge on the other side of the recreation ground or at a pay and display behind the old Regal Cinema for £4.50 - ask Janet/other traders for directions. All cars must be removed between 9am – 2.30pm (traffic free zone).
Toilet information	Public toilets are to the left of the Town Hall and down the lane a few yards.
Best place for a coffee	A coffee van is part of the general market.
Any other useful information about the market for a new trader	Wells is an all year around weekly market so traders are making a big commitment. As your pitch is rented from the council, any time away needs to be booked well in advance - if we can't find a replacement trader you will be liable for the full fee. General traders stay until 4pm so we need to pack up with minimum disruption- first vehicles not to load up before 2.30pm
Costs	£26.50 on the day; £24.50 on invoice (£3 discount for veg/plants)
