

COLLINGHAM PLAY PARK

Terms of reference for committee to oversee refurbishment and redesign of the Play Park Swinderby Road, Collingham:

To make the Play Park an area suitable for all residents of all abilities to use and want to visit.

To reflect the views of the current users and potential users of the Play Park.

To make the play equipment suitable for the children of Collingham up to 16 years old and 7 years to 16 years for the skateboard park.

To consider the needs and views of adult residents for outdoor exercise equipment.

The redesign to include landscaping, fencing and gates.

Apply for grants so that as much as possible of the project may be funded by a grant agency.

Conduct survey of users: parents, children, youth club and skateboarders. Contact Baby and Toddler group, Pre-school, John Blow School and Friends of John Blow School. Contact groups for adult residents – William Bailey Social Club and Good Companions.

Feed information from consultations and professional design of whole Play Park including the skateboard park.

Ensure that seating and benches are available at appropriate points around Play Park.

The Play Park Committee will make recommendations for final decision by the Parish Council.

The Financial Regulations of Collingham Parish Council will apply to the Play Park Committee and all grants applied for will be in the name of Collingham Parish Council.

Reports of meetings will be proved as and when necessary to the full council meetings of the Parish Council.
