TWG is looking at options to try and reduce speed.

TWG is also looking at which signs should be replaced / repaired, including the signs at the school which are too far away from the school. A 25mph flashing light may be a consideration.

The other two entrances need to be tidied up and potentially gates to be installed to encourage speed reduction.
