### **Planning**

- **Ewelme Site A:** AVDC gave outline permission for up to 22 dwellings on the north end of Swan Field land south of Little Marsh Road and east of Swan Lane (16/03379/AOP).
- · AVDC gave permission for **Clenlyn, Scotts Lane** (17/04111/APP) for the demolition of existing structure and erection of single storey rear extension.
- An appeal has been made against AVDC's decision to refuse permission for an extension at **May Cottage, Summerstown** (17/00091/REF).

Council had raised no objections to the original application.

- An application has been made to fell a sycamore at **23 Rectory Close** and replant with a 3.5m silver birch. Council will discuss on January 9<sup>th</sup>.
- · An application has been made by C Parker & Sons (17/04607/ADP) for approval of 'reserved matters' for the appearance, landscaping, layout and scale of a residential development of five dwellings at **Whales Lane**. This follows their application 13/03375/AOP which was given outline permission by AVDC on April 21<sup>st</sup> 2015. Council will discuss on January 9<sup>th</sup>.

### **Post Office**

The contract has been agreed for a post office at The Plough and there will now be a period of consultation by Post Office Limited, followed by equipment installation and training. The 'GoLive' date has yet to be announced.

## **Thames Water**

Council was notified by Bucks County Council on December 22nd of a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order application by Thames Water to close Church Street, 24 hours a day, for eight weeks from February 19<sup>th</sup> to April 13<sup>th</sup>. Some residents in the area have objected to the proposal, which had a closing date of December 29<sup>th</sup>. Meanwhile many residents have received letters from Thames Water including other planned work in Bicester Road from January 8<sup>th</sup>, Station Road from April 6<sup>th</sup> and Millfield Avenue from April 11<sup>th</sup>.

# **Budget**

The MGPC budget for 2018-19 of £24,714 was finalised at the December Council meeting. The precept to meet these costs via AVDC will be £24,000, up 7% on the current year. This is about £1 per week for a Band D property.
