QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

84% thought affordable housing
should be for local people

83% said new housing should enable
young people to live in the area

83% said that it was “very important”
that new development provided
off street parking

81% said new housing should enable
older people to move into more
suitable accommodation for their
age and abilities

70% thought new housing should help
pay for local infrastructure

OBJECTIVES

To meet local housing need without
overburdening the stretched local
infrastructure, including roads.

To preserve the character of the
parish through influencing the
design of future development.

TRANSPORT

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION FEEDBACK

You told us:

You would like a vehicle weight restriction throughout the village

A better evening bus service is needed, including a route through the village

The chicanes in Main Street should be taken out or redesigned to reduce congestion

More speed enforcement is needed

QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

97% were concerned about the volume of traffic travelling through the parish

95% were concerned with the impact of future development in the parish with regard to access due to increased traffic congestion

95% were concerned about the speed of traffic

89% were concerned about the amount of large vans and lorries travelling through the village

75% thought that weight restrictions should be introduced

1/3 of respondents requested new cycle ways throughout the parish

OBJECTIVES

To work with the Highways Authority to improve road safety and ease traffic congestion in the parish.

To introduce new cycleways in and around the parish, and to maintain the existing footpath network, to improve connection to community

ENVIRONMENT, HERITAGE, CONSERVATION

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION FEEDBACK

You told us:

It is important to maintain green open spaces, views and footpaths

Pavements and street lighting need improving

The conservation area should be protected

QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

93% were concerned about development of Aylesbury encroaching onto the parish

93% use the countryside for walking / rambling

84% said it was very important for them to be able to walk to the countryside

80% would like to see less litter and fly-tipping in the parish

78% would like more wildlife meadows and corridors

42% were concerned about the condition / narrowness of pavements

A number of comments were made about poor street lighting for pedestrians

OBJECTIVES

To protect green spaces and important views of the countryside and to help maintain the rural and historic character of the parish.

To maintain significant green space between the historic village of Weston Turville and the growth of Aylesbury

EDUCATION AND HEALTH

COMMUNITY CONSULTATION FEEDBACK

You told us:

Plan school provision before development is approved to ensure sufficient school places in the parish

Increased medical facilities (Health Centre and GP) within the Parish

Improve pedestrian access to the local school to encourage walking

QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

99% said it was important to have adequate provision of school places within the parish to accommodate children in the parish and the ability for them to walk to school

45% said it was difficult to book an appointment with the doctor

87% *found it easy to access optician services*

63% *found it easy to visit a pharmacy*

OBJECTIVES

To improve access to health services for the parish

To ensure sufficient capacity for children living in the parish to access primary education within the parish.
