

Lyneham and Bradenstoke Parish Council WW1 Tree Planting Commemoration Project



Bradenstoke Recreational Field

This project was started in October 2017 by the Community Engagement Manager for Royal Wootton Bassett and Cricklade Community Area, Chair of Lyneham and Bradenstoke Parish Council and a volunteer from the community.

A bid was placed for trees to plant along the MOD/ Bradenstoke Recreational Field boundary. A record of those village residents who gave their lives in military service in WW1 accompanied the bid.

We were successful in the bid and the trees were delivered in October 2018. The Parish Council at that time felt the trees were too small to plant in the recreational field so they were planted in a resident's field to allow them to mature a little.

The time has come to transplant the trees to their final destination.

The project, initiated by Wiltshire Council, suggested a community event was held for the planting.

We would like to follow this suggestion, holding a planting event late October/early November 20.

A design of a plaque is also needed, and we would like to hear of ideas from the community.
