WHAT'S HAPPENED?

Bramley Parish Council News:

Bramley Parish Council would like to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

We would like to thank everybody who was involved in the Christmas Lights switch on event, which was a huge success and the village is looking beautiful!

Well done everyone, we appreciate all your efforts.

- Missing Bus Stop Shelter opposite ASDA in February this was hit by a vehicle. Despite repeated chases and pressure, the install date received from Waverley is now February 2026. WBC have cited procurement issues as the reason for the lengthy delay.
- **Fuel Leak** following reports of odours, fuel on the ground and continuing connectivity issues Chair Austin has requested an update meeting with all parties. Latest updates here.
- **Upcoming 20mph public consultation** Surrey County Council have held initial meetings about increase road safety in the area via 20mph zones. Cllr Deanus and Chair Austin initially suggested Snowdenham

Lane, Central High Street and Station Road (including offshoot roads), plus extension of the 30mph zone heading north on the A281 towards Gosden Common for public consultation. More details to follow in early 2026.

- **Eastwood Road playground** we are delighted to see the children enjoying the space. Phase 2 including a refurbishment of the football area is in the planning and quote collection phase. Consensus feedback is to include goalposts but also to ensure that the space is prioritised for younger children.
- Chestnut Way Playground WBC has now confirmed refurbishment of the football area is taking longer than planned and WBC has passed on apologies for the delay. It is likely new grass will be relaid, weather permitting. The playground area has seen some replacement of damaged parts, but no refurbishment is presently planned.
- Bramley Bowls Club the parish council acquired the site of the bowling club in July of this year on condition it was retained as a green space for the recreation and enjoyment of residents. The plan is to maintain the bowling green for croquet, bowls and other lawn games, and to install picnic tables at one end, plant shrubs along the sides and also install some adult exercise equipment where the clubhouse (which is unsafe and needs to be demolished) now stands. At the last council meeting it was agreed that two councillors should develop a proposal to put to residents. This work is ongoing.
- **Mill Lane Pond** a new purchaser is resolving insurance concerns, so for public safety a 3ft fence has been placed on the water line. BPC is working constructively with the new owner, including re-siting of the bin and bench to maintain use and enjoyment of the lake view.
- **Gosden Common** BPC has recently undertaken work to improve security, including new locks and strengthening the bunds which will be sown with wildflowers in time for Spring. The Pavilion car park has also been improved.
- **Parish Budget** BPC is currently working on the 2026 budget, If you have any views on work please attend our next Council meeting or email us.
- Local Government Reorganisation On 28th October Government confirmed Surrey will be reorganised into two unitary authorities, West and East. Elections will be held May 2026. For more information click here for Surrey CC's updates or here for Waverley BC's latest update.
