NDP— What, Why, Where

What is an NDP?

The Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP) will be a document that sets out planning policies for our parish, used to help decide whether to approve planning applications. It is written by the local community, the people who know and love the area, rather than the Local Planning Authority, in our case, Aylesbury Vale Borough Council.

Our NDP must be in conformity with and not conflict with local or national planning policy. It will seek to promote sustainable development in our parish and must not block development. It is not a wish list of projects but a planning policy document for future development.

What area will it cover?

The Ivinghoe Parish Neighbourhood Plan covers the Parish of Ivinghoe which comprises the village of Ivinghoe, Ivinghoe Aston and a small part of Ringshall as shown on the map above.

Why do we need an NDP?

The NDP can help ensure our community gets the right types of development, in the right place, which reflect our priorities and deliver tangible local benefits, enabling residents to decide how the area where we live, work and play will change over time. It is a legal document and will have real weight in planning decisions giving us more control over what happens in our community.

Current NDP activities



Having recently secured funding from Locality (www.locality.org.uk), the Ivinghoe Parish NDP team is now working with specialist consultants to help us plan the programme of work needed to develop and consult on the NDP.
