Membership – General Terms and Conditions

- The name of the club is Bilton Bowling Club which is situated at Bawnmore Road, Bilton, Rugby.
- > The club is run as a Community Amateur Sports Club. The main object of the club is to promote the amateur sport of Bowls in Rugby and community participation in the same and to provide other social functions for the benefit of the club and its members.
- Annual membership runs from the 1st March to last day of February. Payment is due on the 1st March; the club will run a Registration / payment event in March (advertised on club notice board and web site). The annual subscription fees are agreed at the AGM held in February and advertised on the club website and notice boards.
- Application for membership from new players, can be made initially via the website or via the Membership Secretary. New players will be invited to the club where the application process can be completed and payment can be arranged.
- ➤ Probationary membership will be offered to all NEW members at a reduced annual subscription for the first year. Probationary members will however be restricted to the number of team games in which they can participate, at the discretion of the appropriate committee and /or team captain.
- In line with Warwickshire Women's Bowling Association rules (WWBA), members who join Bilton Bowling Club as their secondary club should declare this at the time of joining or renewing. They will not be eligible to enter the club Ladies 2 wood singles, Ladies pairs or Ladies championship competition which are allocated points by WWBA. All other participation is actively encouraged and you will **not** need to pay a second affiliation fee.
- ➤ Upon acceptance for membership, new members can be issued with a key to the front door, giving access during the day to changing facilities and club notice boards as well as mats and jacks. There is a £15 deposit required. Keys remain the property of Bilton Bowling Club. Upon resignation from the club the keys should be returned to the Secretary and the deposit will be refunded. Replacements for lost keys will be charged at £15.00.
- Flat soled footwear must be worn at all times on the green. Please change from your outdoor shoes to protect the green. Appropriate club clothing to be worn for all club matches.
- The summer season (i.e. the green is open) runs from Mid-April to the end of September. The green is available normally from 11am daily until dusk. Booking of rinks is not always necessary but rinks can be pre-booked in advance. Team matches take precedence over any other play.
- The artificial (all weather) rink is available all year round, normally between 11am and dusk.
- > The club is run by its members for its members. It is hoped that members will be able to volunteer at some time during the year. Details of opportunities to help include helping with team teas, supporting the bar manager, cleaning and maintenance of the buildings and grounds. Details from the Management Committee.
- ➤ The decision of the Management Committee is final in case of any dispute.
