### 3. VILLAGE PLAN REPORT

The village plan has been distributed with voting forms and answers are coming in.

The Vale of Aylesbury plan has been inspected, and not approved. It has therefore been withdrawn and will be re-drafted. South eastern plan has also been withdrawn. Current guidance for Chearsley will be the District Local Plan which has been extended to cover period when there is no Local Plan.

### 4. HIGHWAYS AND OPEN AREAS

The devolved budget has a provision for parish Councils to control their own grass cutting budget, but there is currently no funding available, so moneys available will probably only be he reduction seen in costs for contractors not visiting village

The diseased sycamore tree tree opposite the Bell in will be removed.

LAF. An extra movable speed sign will be applied for. The priorities this year are Teenagers and Communities and there is no LAF funding available to assist with kerbing.WI Councillor Mrs Lazaruk advised the meeting that there had been requests for a Skate Park

Rights of Way team are going to put steps in the bank up to footpath 9 in Church Lane. It was reported that the Church Lane road sign at that location is damaged. Clerk to report to Bucks CC

The tree overhanging Farmyard footpath with be trimmed at Councillor Lewis's expense.

## 6. SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDERS

It was suggested that the matters of grass cutting, verges and other open spaces await the results of the Village plan, when they would be incorporated into the action plan.

There is a tree by the Church that needs attention. The tree officer will be asked to have a look by the PCC

There is a Housing association House on Winchendon Road that has been empty for some time. It needs renovation before it can be occupied again

Thames Water compensation for damage to Verges during the time the pumping station at the bottom of Church Lane was out of commission. This is to be investigated.

Cllr Heybrook suggested designating areas where people could be asked to look after wild flowers outside their properties as there was still some money left from the donation received a couple of years ago.

There were further questions regarding the Village Plan. When the document was approved it would be bought back to the Parish Council for adoption. There will be one vote per person, and the document will be delivered to every house.
