1. The Order

This allows the Traffic Authority (Norfolk County Council) to temporarily restrict or prohibit the use of a road and/or footpath.

2. The 'Propose To' Notice (PT)

This is the public Notice we must advertise at least seven days before making an Order.

3. The 'Has Made' Notice (HM)

This is the public Notice we must advertise within 14 days of making an Order.

Please note a new format is being introduced and for those looking for the plan, if a separate one is not attached, it can now be found on page 2 of the notices.

The proposed order comes into effect on the date shown. The date on the notices is when they will appear in the Eastern Daily Press. If we have to change any dates, we will let you know. If you have any questions about the order and notices, please contact Alison Wilton on (01603) 222591.

If you have any questions about the work, please contact the Area Highways Office on the number given on the notices.

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C117 Hale Road from its junction with U33278 Ramms Lane to its junction with U33315 Black Drift in the PARISH OF NECTON because of works to facilitate the installation of TROD and drainage works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from (i) 9th March 2020 to 17th March 2020; and (ii) 19th March 2020 to 6th April 2020; for the duration of the works only when signs indicating the closure are in place.

Alternative route is via: C117 Hale Road/ Necton Road/ Cook Road/ School Road, V116 Station Road/ Swaffham Road/ North Pickenham Road, C562 Norwich Road, C117 Tuns Road (Necton/ Holme Hale/ North Pickenham/ Sporle with Palgrave/ Swaffham).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

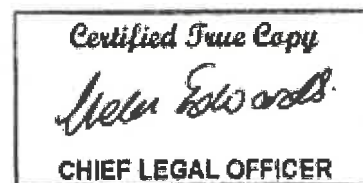

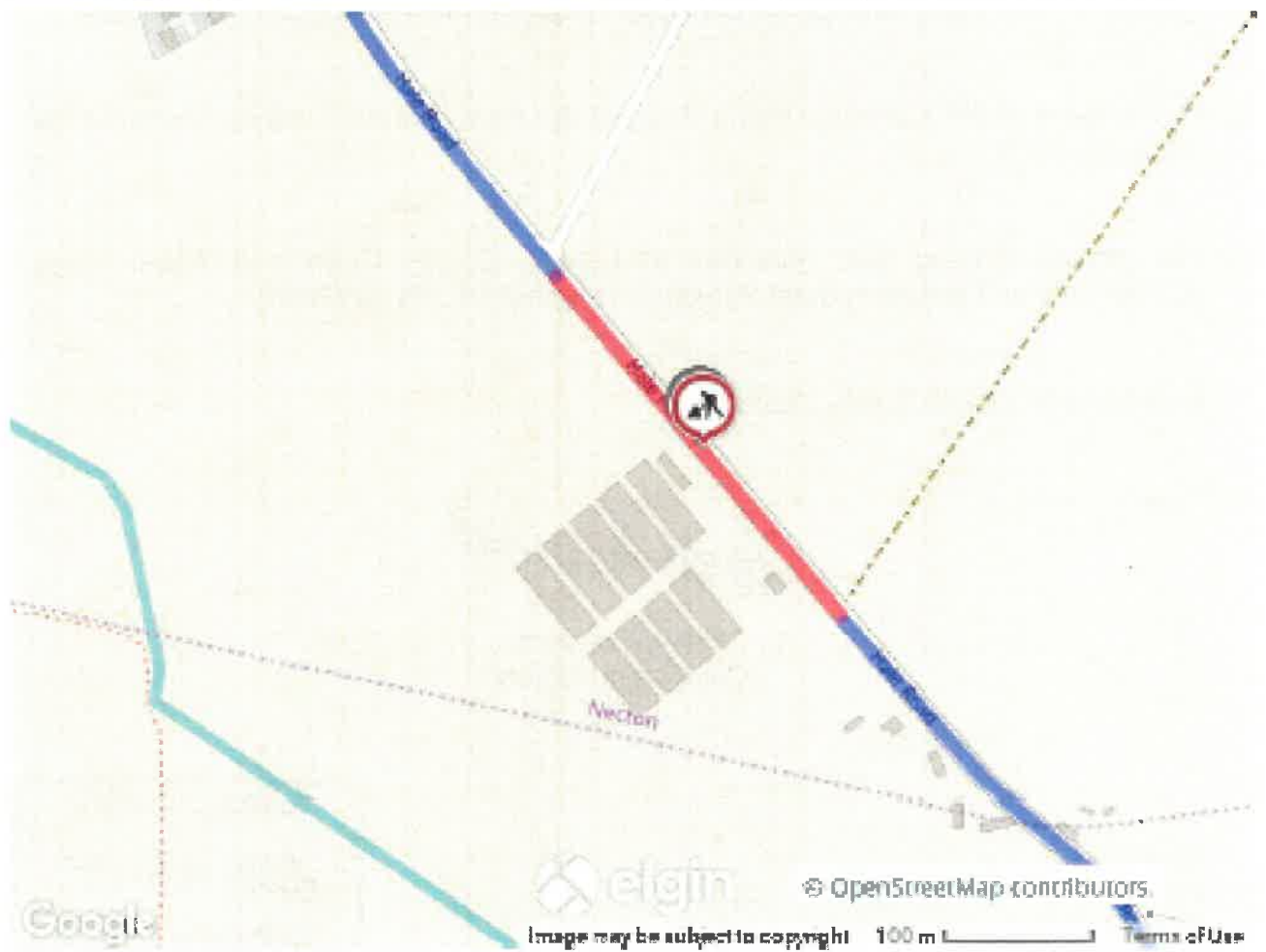

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2020
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)**

ORDER prohibiting the use by vehicles of the C117 Hale Road from its junction with U33278 Ramms Lane to its junction with U33315 Black Drift in the PARISH OF NECTON

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that:-
 - (i) works to facilitate the installation of TROD and drainage works are required at the C117 Hale Road from its junction with U33278 Ramms Lane to its junction with U33315 Black Drift in the PARISH OF NECTON (hereinafter referred to as the said road) and:
 - (ii) that in consequence traffic over the said road should be prohibited with effect from (i) 9th March 2020 to 17th March 2020; and (ii) 19th March 2020 to 6th April 2020; for the duration of the works only when signs indicating the closure are in place.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from (i) 9th March 2020 to 17th March 2020; and (ii) 19th March 2020 to 6th April 2020; for the duration of the works only when signs indicating the closure are in place the said road SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle.
