Various Roads, Swale (Surface Treatment)

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2022

To allow carriageway preservation works to be carried out as part of a Surface Treatment Scheme, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads, Swale.

This Order takes effect on or after 17th March 2022 for a period of up to 18 months or until works have been completed. It may be necessary for some of the roads to be closed for multiple occasions for each phase of the works. Planned dates will be published in advanced of the works on One.Network and indicated by signage displayed on site 14 days before they start.

After the Surface Treatment works, a temporary speed limit of 40 & 20 mph may need to be imposed in place on certain roads for a period of up to 7 days. Where the 40 & 20 mph Speed Limit does apply, this will be clearly indicated by relevant signs displayed on site.

These works are subject to weather and other factors which may potentially cause changes at short notice; every effort will be made to keep as close as possible to the planned dates that are notified, and any changes will be publicised.

SCHEDULE

Road Closures

Borden Lane, Borden

The road will be closed between the junctions with A2 and Homesdale Road & Riddles Lane and Bottom Pond Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for phase A is via Adelaide Drive, A2 London Road and vice versa.

The alternative route for Phase B is via Adelaide Road, A2 London Road, Wises Lane and vice versa.

Bull Lane, Newington

The road will be closed between the junctions with A2 High Street and Wormsdale Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Wormsdale Hill, Maidstone Road, Chestnut Street, Key Street Roundabout, A2 Keycol Hill, Boyces Hill, High Street and vice versa.

Chalkwell Road, Sittingbourne

The road will be closed between the junctions with A2 London Road and B2005 Roundabout, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards A2 is via B2006 St Paul's Street, B2006 Mill Way, B2006 Eurolink Way, Crown Quay Lane, St Michael's Road, Dover Street, A2 West Street, A2 London Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards B2006 Roundabout is via A2 London Road, St Michael's Road, Crown Quay Road, B2006 Eurolink Way, Mill Way, St Paul's Street.

The Street, Lower Halstow

The road will be closed from outside the Stream and the junction with Vicarage Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for buses is via A2 Hartlip Hill, A22 London Road, Otterham Quay Lane, Horsham Lane, Forge Lane, The Street

The alternative route is via Raspberry Hill, Old Ferry Road, Sheppey Way, Key Street Roundabout, A2 Keycol Hill, A2 Boyces Hill, High Street, London Road, Breach Lane and vice versa.

School Lane, Bapchild

The road will be closed between the junctions with A2 London Road and Panteny Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route is via Panteny Lane, A2 London Road and vice versa.

Staple Street, Hernhill

The road will be closed between the junctions with Staplestreet Road and Church Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards the A299 is via Thanet Way: Staplestreet Road, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, Boughton Bypass, Brenley Corner, A299 Thanet Way, Whitstable Road, Staplestreet Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards Dunkirk is via Staple Street, A299 Thanet Way, Brenley Corner, Boughton Bypass, Canterbury Road, Stocker's Hill, The Street, Staplestreet Road

Tunstall Road, Tunstall

The road wil be closed between the junctions with Cranbrook Drive and Hearts Delight, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards Cranbrook Drive is via Hearts Delight Road, Hearts Delight, Bannister Hill, Borden Lane, A2 London Road, St Michael's Road, Dover Road, West Street, Park Road, Gore Court Road, Woodstock Road, Tunstall Road.

The alternative route for traffic travelling towards Hearts Delight Road is via Tunstall Road, Woodstock Road, Gorecourt Road, Park Road, West Street, A2 London Road, Borden Road, Bannister Road, Hearts Delight and Hearts Delight Road.

Speed Limits

It will be necessary to impose a 40 mph speed limit on the approach to, and then a 20 mph speed limit through, working sites on various roads in Swale, as detailed below.

Borden Lane, Borden - between the junctions with A2 and Homesdale Road & Riddles Lane and Bottom Pond Road.

Bull Lane, Newington - between the junctions with A2 and Wormsdale Hill.

Chalkwell Road, Sittingbourne - between the junctions with A2 London Road and B2005 Roundabout.

Chequers Road (Including Chapel Street), Eastchurch / Minster On Sea - between the junctions with Back Street and Plough Lane.

The Street, Lower Halstow - from outside the Stream to the junction with Vicarage Line.

School Lane, Bapchild - between the junctions with A2 London Road and Panteny Lane.

Sheppey Way, Leysdown - between the junctions with A249 Roundabout and Lower Road Roundabout.

Staple Street, Hernhill - between the junctions with Staplestreet Road and Church Hill.

Tunstall Road, Tunstall - between the junctions with Cranbrook Drive and Hearts Delight.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while surface treatment works are undertaken by Kent County Council.
