HGV NEED TO TRAVEL ON THE VERGE TO PASS EACH OTHER



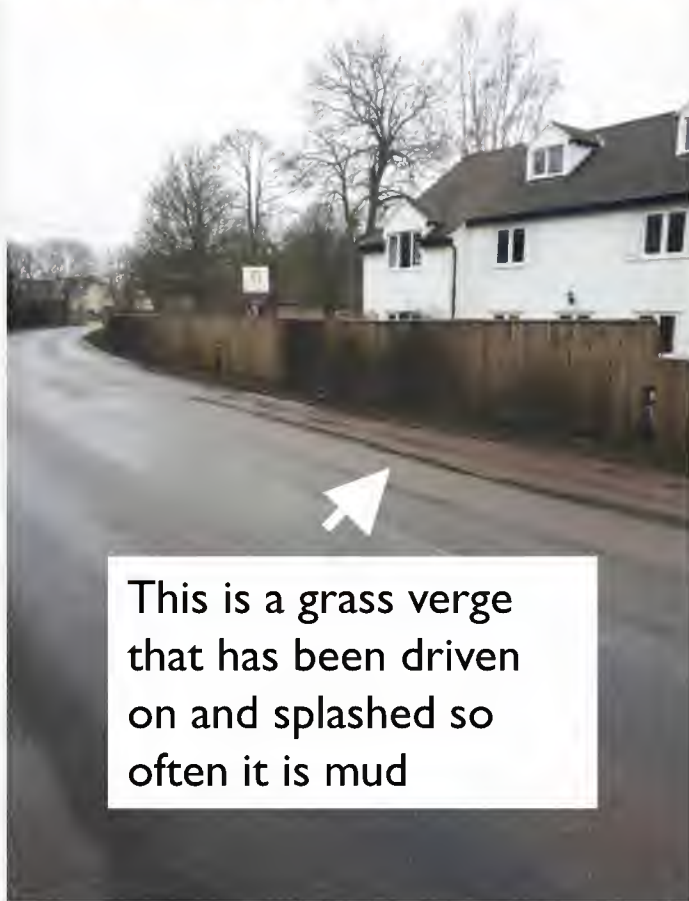
LITTLE ROOM FOR CYCLISTS
