18/12 – 1: Apologies for Absence:

18/12 – 2: Minutes:

Mr Blackford proposed that the minutes of the previous sub-committee meeting held on 17th May 2017 be agreed with the no amendments. This was seconded by Mrs Garner and agreed unanimously
