Progress with the Neighbourhood Plan

We have made a lot of progress since our last update sent out in July 2018.

Thanks to some great work by members of the Steering Group and our consultants OpenPlan we will have a working draft of the Neighbourhood Plan by the beginning of December.

We will be consulting all residents and stakeholders on the contents of the draft Neighbourhood Plan and we expect to upload the draft plan by the middle of December. We have booked the **Arthur Radford Centre for a 'drop in' session on Sunday January 6 from 10.00am until 4pm**. All residents will have the opportunity to hear presentations about the plan, ask questions and suggest any changes. The consultation will end on 19 February 2019.

The Plan will then be considered by Newark & Sherwood District Council before it is scrutinised by an independent examiner. The final stage will be a referendum held in June at a date to be confirmed to decide if the Plan will be adopted for planning purposes.

Fiskerton Defibrillator Project

Thanks to the hard work of residents and the generosity of the Bromley and the WI to date, we have raised **£1690** towards having a defibrillator sited outside the Village Shop. We are having a **GRAND RAFFLE** which will be drawn at the Bromley on the **Northern Soul night starting at 9pm on 23 November**. We just need just over **£400** to reach our target of **£2000**.

We have a meeting on Monday 19 November at Morton Church Hall at 7pm before the Parish Council Meeting to decide which is the most suitable and what are the best arrangements for running it.

Christmas Events in our villages this year

We are holding the annual **Christmas Lights 'Switch On'** and the unveiling of the Village Green Christmas Tree on **Sunday 2 December 4-5pm**. This will be followed by a **Lantern Walk on 27 December starting from the Village Green at 4pm**. Future events include a Fashion and Art Show Proceeds from these events will go towards the Defibrillator fund and should take us to our target of £2000.
