 Pte. Herbert Thomas Botting, Lincoln Regt., second son of Mr. and Mrs. T. J. Botting, of Upper Halling, died on April 21st in a Canadian Hospital in France, from gunshot wounds in the chest. He was 19 years of age in December last, and joined the colours on Feb. 23rd, 1917. Prior to enlisting he was employed in munition work at Cliffe-at-Hoo, where he was highly respected. Both he and his brother, also referred to on this page, were educated at the Halling Council School.
