## **Manston - an Update**

There has been a lot of "Fake News" about Manston reported in the local press, much of it emanating from UKIP led TDC as they seek to justify their broken promises regarding Manston Airport. The revised Local Plan, which was supposed in the media to kill off hopes of retaining the Airport, is at present no more than a draft, is, in the opinion many, deeply flawed, and will be subject to rigorous public scrutiny and consideration by a planning inspector. The suggestion that RiverOak has pulled out of Manston is also incorrect. Two senior Main Board directors of RiverOak Corporation of America have pulled out of that company, and spent nearly \$1m to buy out their interests, to establish RiverOak UK as a British enterprise and to focus on the re-opening of Manston Airport. What greater commitment could there be than that?






