The *Planning Policy committee meets 28 June to approve Local Plan Plan period to 2039 not 2050* So land / housing numbers will be reduced? And suggested that we argue to take out 6k houses, as it would only ever be viable till the end of plan period if it is to be predicated on MK Mass Transit system

## SPD consultation now out and runs till 18 August

Areas that I think we need to consider

- 1: the use of the Swan Valley units as the reference point for Large Units seems odd comparing unit size to a site adjacent to the M1 and those by the A508 and in a residential area is not a sensible comparison
- 2: we should push to say that no single unit including car parking and ancillary buildings should take up more than say 15% of the total area
- 3: we should try to say that no large units should be on the Cosgrove site this only seems explicit on the Woolgrowers site at Towcester
- 4: rather than say 'anything along the Stratford Road needs to be developed sensitively'. We should try to get that rather loose definition tightened up not sure if we can get restrictions to  $\underline{\text{no } 24/7}$  use, but we should at least ask for it make sure that lighting is correct etc
- \* Need to drum up local support so there are resident comments and not just those from the vested interests.

I am also sure there will be other things the PC will want in addition
