Speed Limit Reminder signs

These flashing signs are popping up all over the place intermittently, and serve as a good reminder to all to slow down. Most of the roads in Baughurst are now 30 mph zones, and speed checks by our local constabulary are not uncommon. Take care!

Speedwatch

Our new Speed Indicator Device is now in constant use, not just in Baughurst but in neighbouring parishes too, where we are renting it out. You may see groups of individuals manning the machine - they will be wearing high visibility jackets with 'Community Speedwatch' lettering on the back. Slow down! Footpaths

Further copies of both edition 1 (circular walks within the parish), and edition 2 (circular walks from the parish) are both available at £1.50 from Tadley Library.

The Parish Council continues to walk and monitor all the paths in the parish on a rotating basis. Please do let us know if you see any problems on routes which you may walk.

Community Transport

Baughurst, Kingsclere and Tadley Councils will, by the time you receive this, have launched the provision of a local bus serving all three communities on routes and at times which are not normally covered by the standard bus operators. The route starts in Monk Sherborne, and weaves its way to Tadley via Ramsdell, Ashford Hill and Headley, Kingsclere and Baughurst. The purple bus can be hailed from the road/ Bus passes are acceptable. However, set-down and pick-up points can be agreed on so excellent for those who find it difficult to walk far. Fliers are being distributed, and the scheme is currently on a three month trial - use it or lose it! Initially it will run on Wednesdays and Fridays, leaving at 10.00 am from Monk Sherborne, and arriving at Tadley Sainsbury's at 10.50 am. A flier is enclosed telling you a little more about it.

Planning

Open spaces

We are about to take possession of land to the rear of Long Grove, once owned by the Ministry of Defence, and now a narrow green strip. We plan to carry out a programme of arboricultural inspection, which will inevitably result in the felling of dead trees, and remedial pruning of others. The area includes the tumuli - ancient burial grounds - and we hope to devise a scheme to protect them from being used as a cycle track.

We are proud of our play areas at Long Grove and Wolverton, and try to keep them in good repair, clean and tidy. Do let us know if you witness vandalism or wilful damage.

Flytipping

Please DO NOT throw your rubbish into green areas, or leave in hedgerows, or down country lanes. It is an offence in law, and if spotted, you will be reported and fined. The build up of dying vegetation also encourages the spread of rats, which is an ongoing problem in the parish. The bill for the removal of flytipping is ultimately paid by you, the Council tax payer.
