	<ul> <li>Presentation on behalf of Abbotts Ann Vision detailing the proposals in the Housing Needs Survey</li> </ul>	
	A presentation was made on behalf of Abbotts Ann Vision (AAV) by a number of their members, recapping the results of the housing needs survey, the definition of a Community Land Trust, Possible Alternative structures to a Community Land Trust (CLT), the route that will be taken by AAV to progress the project and achieve the recommendations by Action Hampshire in their report April-August 2016 (previously accepted by the council), and possible funding sources. Part of the presentation included a short talk from Judy Lucas and Geoff Philpots of Whickham CLT as to their experiences of starting and running their organisation, they were thanked by the Council for their time and input. The presentation slides will be made available on the village website. It was made clear that the council were only being asked for their support in principle of the proposals.	
	- Formal questions and answers regarding the proposals	
	The council asked a number of questions regarding the set up and operation of the Whickham trust and the responses are summarised;	
	The Trust is Operated by the members of the CLT with rents and minor maintenance being handled by a managing agent.	
	There is a National organization of CLT's (The National Community Land Trusts Network) that is very active and of great assistance during start-up and is an effective lobbying group to National Government.	
	The CLT could be wound up through normal statutory processes for a charity, and any land and building assets must be disposed of to a similar charitable body, and any land owned by the trust must be retained for the original charitable purposes in perpetuity.	
	The council asked of Abbotts Ann Vision number of questions regarding operation of the trust in Abbotts Ann and the responses are summarised;	
	The precise structure of any Land Trust is yet to be decided and will be in full consultation with the public.	
	There are no selected or proposed sites for any construction or land ownership at present.	
	A number of commercial development would be undertaken both to satisfy the need for local "downsizers" which could be covenanted on sale to be maintained for the occupation of existing local residents and other criteria yet to be decided.	
	The profits from the sale of the commercial developments could be utilised only to	

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	fund the development of CLT owned and maintained properties and land.	
	Any profits from the CLT must be returned to the community in the nature of the charitable trust of the CLT.	
	It is the intent of any CLT formed to become members of the National Community Land Trust Network	,

	<ul> <li>It is noted that both Cllr Hayter and Cllr Wells are residents of Manor Close although have no pecuniary or other interest in this application</li> </ul>	NOTE
	- Voted Objection, all agreed for the following reasons: The architectural styles is not in keeping with the other houses in Manor Close. The construction materials are significantly different from the surrounding properties. Surface drainage is intended to flow into the main sewer for which there is no provision of storm drains in Manor Close. It is also noted that the building lir of the other properties is not maintained and encroaches further towards the carriageway and due to the shape of the plot the frontage becomes very narrow to the southern end of the proposed construction. We would also recommend a parking survey and assessment as the road is very congested with parked cars.	ne
