

Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish of Babworth

The Localism Act of 2011 has given Parish Councils the power to shape what their neighbourhood will look like in the future.

Babworth Parish Council has made the decision to take on these new powers and to prepare what is known as a 'Neighbourhood Plan'. Once finalised, it will help ensure that any new housing or business development is controlled and meets local needs in terms of type, location and appearance; that important local green spaces are protected from development and that heritage assets are safeguarded. The Neighbourhood Plan, once approved, will be an important document that must be taken into account by Bassetlaw District Council when determining planning applications.

The Parish Council, with professional support, will drive this process forward over the next 12-18 months, but it needs YOUR involvement NOW to make sure that the Neighbourhood Plan truly reflects the needs and aspirations of local people. In the coming months there will be a number of opportunities for you to contribute to the Neighbourhood Plan as it develops and to find out how it is progressing.

We invite you to a launch event which will take place in Ranby Village Hall on Saturday 16th July 2022 between 11:00 am and 1:30 pm.

We want to hear from you about what is positive and what is not about living and working in our community. What do we need to retain and what do we need to change?

This is your chance to really make a difference to the future of Babworth and Ranby.
