1 Introduction

- 1.1 This accessibility statement applies to www.uffingtonparish.gov.uk
- 1.2 This website is run by Uffington Parish Council ('the Council'). We want as many people as possible to be able to use this website. For example, that means you should be able to:
 - Change colours, contrast levels and fonts
 - Zoom in up to 300% without the text spilling off the screen
 - Navigate most of the website using just a keyboard
 - Navigate most of the website using speech recognition software
 - Listen to most of the website using a screen reader (including the most recent versions of JAWS, NVDA and VoiceOver)
- 1.3 We have also made the website text as simple as possible to understand. [AbilityNet](#) has advice on making your device easier to use if you have a disability.

2 How accessible this website is

- 2.1 We have audited the website against the latest accessibility standards and, whilst most of the site is compliant, we know some parts of this website are not fully accessible, for example:
 - Text may not reflow in a single column when you change the size of the browser window
 - Most older PDF documents are not fully accessible to screen reader software
 - You may not be able to skip to the main content when using a screen reader

6 Technical information about this website's accessibility

- 6.1 The Council is committed to making its website accessible, in accordance with the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.
- 6.2 The website is built and maintained using the Hugo Fox website builder content management system (CMS) and hosted by Hugo Fox. The CMS allows for simple page creation and a limited ability to adjust various parameters through a customised front end.

7 Compliance status

- 7.1 This website is partially compliant with the 2.2 AA standard, due to the non-compliances listed below.

8 Non-accessible content

- 8.1 The content listed below is non-accessible for the following reasons.

9 Non-compliance with the accessibility regulations

- 9.1 There are no non-compliances in this section; they all fall within the 'Disproportionate Burden' category listed below.

10 Disproportionate burden

- 10.1 Many older Parish Council record documents (eg pdf meeting minutes) may not fully comply and correcting would be a disproportionate burden.

11 Interactive tools and transactions

- 11.1 The design of the forms is governed by the CMS used by the hosting company (Hugo Fox). We are unable to modify this.
- 11.2 We've assessed the cost of fixing the issues with navigation and accessing information, and with interactive tools and transactions. We believe that doing so now would be a [disproportionate burden](#) within the meaning of the accessibility regulations. We will make another assessment when the supplier contract is up for renewal, although there are currently no plans to do this.

12 PDFs and other documents

- 12.1 Some of our PDFs and Word documents are essential to providing our services. For example, we have PDFs with information on how users can access our services, and forms published as Word documents. We use PDFs for information that should not or does not need to be changed by readers. We use Word forms for documents that require users to be able to edit them.
- 12.2 The accessibility regulations [do not require us to fix PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018](#) if they're not essential to providing our services. For example, we do not plan to fix historic Parish Council meeting agendas and minutes which form the majority of such documents.
- 12.3 Any new PDFs or Word documents we publish will meet accessibility standards.

13 Live video

- 13.1 We do not plan to add captions to live video streams because live video is [exempt from meeting the accessibility regulations](#) and we do not currently (October 2025) plan to provide any video streams.

- 13.3 We checked all pages on the site for compliance and corrected faults to the best of our ability or within the practical limitations of the CMS.
