(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2024

Southern Water works.

To allow repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Wardwell Lane, Lower Halstow.

A closure is planned from 2nd April 2024, with estimated completion by 5th April 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT13115043-04 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Wardwell Lane will be closed from the junction with School Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while repair works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Iwade Road (Church Lane), Basser Hill, Sheerness Road, Vicarage Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
