#### 52/2019 Public Forum

Concern was expressed about the amount and size of the debris left in gardens after the bonfire night this needs to be referred to the Church who run the event.

A request was made for the Parish Council to purchase large poppies for display on telegraph poles next November it was agreed to look into this early next year. Action: Clerk to put on Agenda

There are a number of vehicles which are travelling too fast through the village it was suggested that flashing speed limit signs be fitted to telegraph poles. Action: Clerk to investigate price, hire etc.

The recent damage to the verges on Sandy Lane has caused sand to be washed onto the roads and down drains causing skidding and flooding hazards. <u>Action:</u> Clerk to report to highways/street cleaning

# **Report from CIIr Picton**

<u>Secondary Schools</u>: Discussions regarding problems with Secondary Schools admissions have been taking place there are plans for schools to increase numbers by adding extra classrooms and a new school in the future. Parents are advised to ensure that they fill out the application forms correctly and list alternative Schools choices not just one.

<u>Highways</u>: There is now a member driven taskforce addressing the problems. Smaller jobs will be taken back in house and the backlog is being addressed. A customer management system is now in use.
