MINUTES of a PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING held on Wednesday, 17 June 2015 at The Almonry, High Street, Battle at 7.30pm

Present: Cllrs R Jessop (Chairman), D Furness, J Gyngell, M Kiloh, and S Pry.

In Attendance: John Harmer, Andy Beams (Town Clerk)

- **1. Apologies for absence** Cllrs M Howell, M Palmer and A Ratcliffe
- **2. Disclosure of interest** All Members declared a pecuniary interest in application RR/2015/1399/P as the Town Council was the applicant.
- **3. Minutes of the previous meeting held on 3 June 2015** these were proposed by Cllr Kiloh, seconded by Cllr Furness and approved by those present at the meeting.
- 4. Matters arising from previous meetings

None.

5. Report from John Harmer on footpath matters

John Harmer provided an update for Members, including the following points:

- No follow up contact by the footpaths adviser had yet been made with the secretary of the Battle Ramblers.
- Footpath 4 an unofficial diversion had been posted by either the landowner or occupier. The situation had been reported to ESCC, but there had been no progress on the matter.
- Footpath 5 Cllr Boryer had reported a problem, which had been passed onto ESCC by the Battle Ramblers.
- Footpath 82 the landowner had enclosed the path, but the poor surface and overgrown brambles
 were causing a problem. ESCC did not consider this a priority, advising uneven paths were to be
 expected in the countryside. However, the condition was not just of uneven ground but was formed
 of rumble and bicycle parts along with stumps from felled trees and shrubs. ESCC to be asked to deal
 with these issues by the Town Clerk.
- Footpath 87 problems had been reported with the poor surface.
- Bridleway 109 still work in progress

Cllr Kiloh stated she had reported the issues of the ploughed footpath 52 and diversion to ESCC. John Harmer replied that Bev Marks was also looking into the issue.

Cllr Jessop thanked John Harmer for his report, and requested he provide any updates to the Town Clerk, who would circulate to all Members.

 continued lack of updates on long standing cases, and requested the Town Clerk contact RDC to
 ascertain the current situation.

To convert existing double garage, used at present for shop storage, into tea room. Existing garage door to be removed and window installed.

Proposed extensions and alterations with new roof and improvements to driveway.

Redecoration of exterior façade. Replacement of traditional signwriting & swing sign pictorial (retrospective)

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1355/P 55 Virgins Lane, Battle, TN33 0JH

Front, side and rear ground floor extension and loft conversion / raise roof to provide additional living accommodation.

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1375/TN The Watch Oak – Telecommunications site at Chain Lane, Battle, TN33 0HG

Proposed upgrade of telecommunications site 94791.

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1394/P 4 Stream Farm Cottages, Netherfield Road, Netherfield, TN33 0HH

Proposed first floor extension.

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1399/P Battle Cemetery, Marley Lane, Battle, TN33 0BB

Change of use of unimproved grassland to be used as an extended burial area to existing cemetery.

Comment: Due to the previously declared pecuniary interest, The Town Council made no comment on this application

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RR/2015/1407/P Pipers Meadow, Chain Lane, Battle TN33 0HG

Demolition of existing house and garage and construction of new detached and detached double garage and store.

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1409/P Cherry Orchard, Canadia Road, Battle, TN33 0LR

To replace and existing approved triple garage with office over with a three bedroom annexe without kitchen (part retrospective).

Comment: Members recommend refusal for the same reasons as the refused application RR/2015/468/P, as the proposal is outside the development boundary, would create a new dwelling in the ANOB, would result in poor quality accommodation with two detached dwellings sharing a single kitchen, would create more traffic movements on a narrow and poorly accessed road and is excessively bulky compared to neighbouring properties. This is in contravention of RDC policies OSS4 (ii), EN1 (i), EN3 and CO6 (ii).

RR/2015/1424/P Undermill, Caldbec Hill, Battle, TN33 0JS

Timber double garage & garden store & enlarge parking / turning area.

Comment: No objection

RR/2015/1430/L and RR/2015/1436/A Pyke House, Upper Lake, Battle, TN33 0AN

Erection of signage.

Comment: Members object and recommend refusal as the signage is excessive in size, within the conservation area and in contravention of RDC policy EN3.

RR/2015/1440/P Lyndale, Marley Lane, Battle, TN33 ORB

Single storey extension to side, erection of detached garage.

Comment: Members have no objection to the single storey extension, but feel the poor quality design of the proposed garage is in contravention of RDC policy EN3.

8. Business and action plans, and risk assessment

These had previously been circulated, and Members had reviewed the content. A number of suggested amendments were discussed, and some minor alterations were made to the plan.

9. Rother District Council – CIL examination

Cllr Jessop informed Members that the examination was scheduled to take place on 14 July, and offered to attend on behalf of the Town Council to reinforce the previously submitted recommendations of a higher levy for the Battle area.

10. Matters for information / future agenda items

The Town Clerk was asked to ensure all the footpath concerns had been reported to ESCC through the correct channels.

The Town Clerk was asked to contact Hugh Merriman MP to invite him to attend a future meeting of the committee to discuss planning & transport issues.
