

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

PUBLIC SESSION (i) Shropshire Councillor's Report – information given about very difficult financial position of Shropshire Council, concerns about Shire Hall being inaccessible to public. (ii) Police Report – none (iii) Public comments – Clun Mill Youth Hostel is being sold, as part of YHA wider project to dispose of 20% of youth hostels. To be sold as either (i) franchise hostel (ii) independent hostel (iii) alternative use. Important Clun asset for tourism and bringing wide range of visitors to area. Following some discussion regarding CiC suggestion, Council agreed on the following. Proposed by Cllr Angell, seconded by Cllr Shepherd. Passed by majority, Cllr Limond abstained.

Town Hall West wall re-rendering: Cllr Shepherd reported that 2 potential contractors have withdrawn following our requests for documentation regarding Health & Safety and other matters. Cllr Shepherd is contacting a new potential contractor. Cllr Bowles reported that a sub-group of councillors (Cllr Angell, Cllr Shepherd, Cllr Davies, Cllr Bowles, with assistance of the Clerk) have submitted a first-stage application to the historic buildings route of the current funding available from the Wolfson Foundation for the full repairs needed for the Town Hall. Cost estimated at approx. £60,000, of which Council will need to provide £15,000. Clun Town Trust supporting partner as Museum provides weight to application. Will hear response 4 th August, if successful will then make 2 nd stage application. 2. Public toilets Just waiting for Severn Trent to turn off old connection.



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		<p>3. Cemetery Walls – report from Cllrs Shepherd and Duffee</p> <p>(a) Cemetery Have carried out preliminary survey. Retaining wall 60m with varying height 2.5m ± 0.5m. Evidence of further deterioration. Need structural engineer to report on state of wall and priority for repairs. Lychgate: 2 tiles missing, 2 need replacing. Timber ok. Gravestones: regularly checked already by gravestone inspector who lets council know of any issues.</p> <p>(b) St George’s churchyard Preliminary survey. Perimeter wall similar make-up to cemetery wall. Some issues with vegetation, some mortar missing and one crack from top to bottom. Bulging in some areas. Again structural engineer required for inspection and advice on priorities and time frame. Path – seems ok. Lychgate: reasonable condition, possibly some rot in timber, few tiles missing. Headstones: some precarious. 2nd handrail required at disabled entrance and at entrance to crypt. Unsecured manhole cover needs securing. Trees and lighting posts recently attended to.</p> <p>Cllr Angell pointed out that we need to know which gravestones and vaults are listed (perhaps 32 of them) and then to obtain expert guidance for listed monuments and gravestones.</p>
