THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER APRIL 2021

To allow replacement works to be carried out on faulty apparatus, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Redwall Lane, Linton.

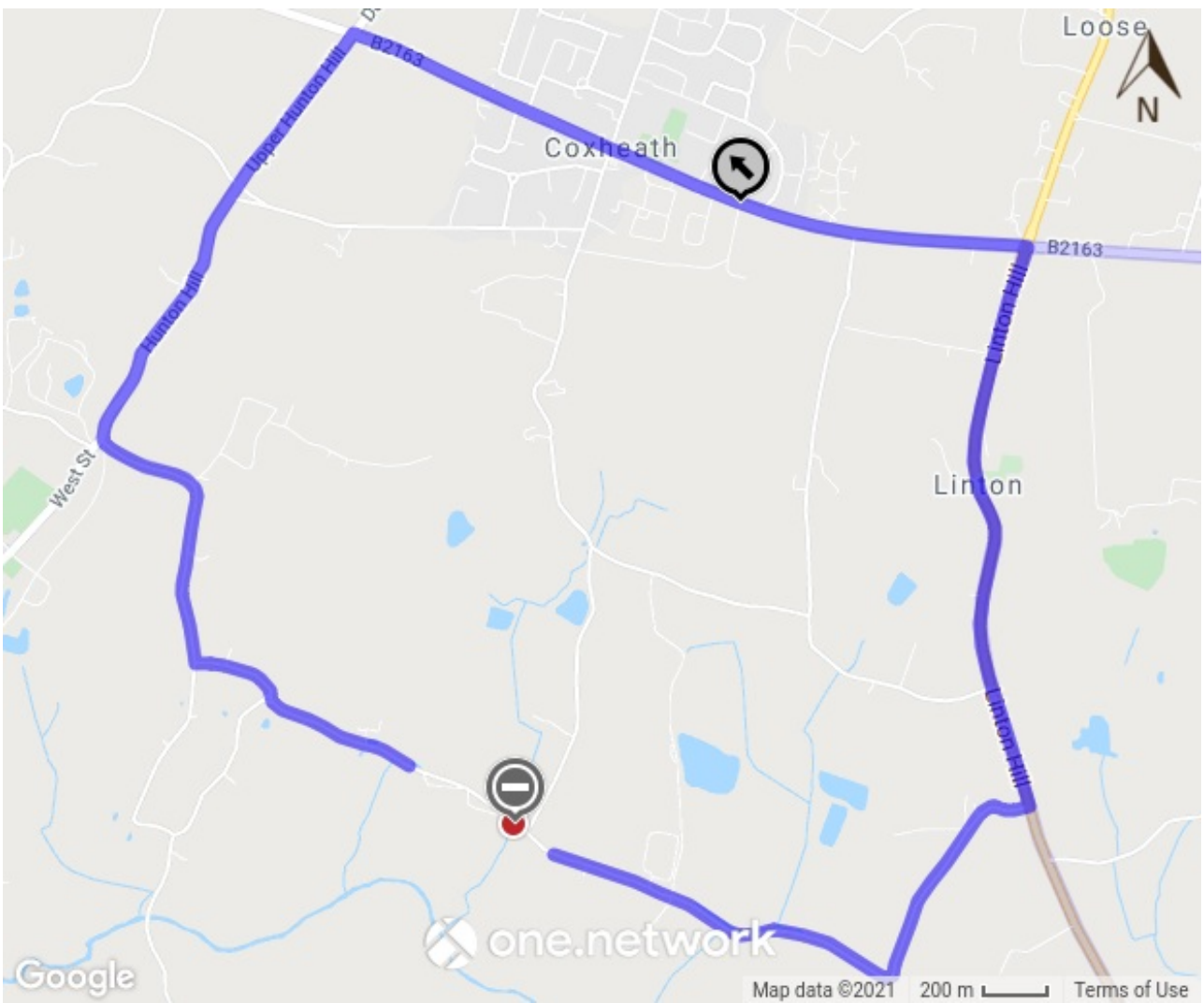
A closure is planned from 15th April 2021, with estimated completion by 19th April 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00624682907 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Redwall Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of River Farm House, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement works on faulty apparatus are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Redwall Lane, East Street, Hunton Hill, Upper Hunton Hill, B2163 Heath Road, A229 Linton Hill and vice versa.
