Manns Hill, Bossingham

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2022

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Manns Hill, Bossingham.

A closure is planned from 31st October 2022, with estimated completion by 24th November 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50055863992-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Manns Hill will be closed between Great Bossingham Farmhouse and Wesley Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while electrical connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Manns Hill, Pett Bottom Road, Bursted Hill, Rectory Lane, Hardres Court Road, The Street and vice versa.
