## 16/778 Planning Applications :

Application No: WND/2021/0144 (Amended) Amendment to planning permission DA/2009/0116 (Change of use of land for holding leisure, tourism and charitable events) to enlarge site area to include land to northwest and eastern side and increase number of show days from 18 to 30 days and extend build and breakdown days from 70 to 90 days per calendar year. Location: Kelmarsh Hall, Main Road, Kelmarsh, Northamptonshire, NN6 9LY : It was **RESOLVED** to comment as follows : If there is to be any extension of show days from 18 to 30 and/or any extension of the build and break down days from 70 to 90 days (hereinafter together called "the Extension Days") then:

1. There should be no live music or recorded music allowed during the Extension Days; and

2. A written record must be made and must be accessible to the Planing Authority recording those events (show days and break down days) that are held on the application site, and specifically referring to those events where live music and/or recorded music takes place.

It must be appreciated that the original planning consent DA/2009/0116 is detailed in its consideration of a music event; the specific number of show days and break down days; and the restrictions concerning noise. To simply propose increasing the number of show days without any consideration of the potential music/noise interference is unacceptable.'
