Moving traffic near installation site	Councillors / public road users	Hi-vis jackets worn; installation carried out at roadside only where safe to do so	Ensure safe working position is chosen away from live carriageway where possible; consider use of a "banksman" role	Councillors (installing)	Completed / ongoing
Slips, trips and uneven ground	Councillors	Visual inspection of ground prior to installation	Stop work if ground is unsafe (ice, mud, debris, poor footing)	Councillors	Monitor on day
Adverse weather (wind, rain, fog, ice)	Councillors / passing motorists	Weather considered before attendance; hi-vis worn	Do not proceed in unsafe conditions (high winds affecting ladders/poles, icy surfaces, poor visibility)	Councillors	Monitor on day
Manual handling / lifting SID unit	Councillors	Two-person lift for all equipment movement	Use correct lifting technique; seek additional help if required; avoid twisting or overreaching	Councillors	On day
Injury, accident or emergency situation	Councillors	Mobile phones carried; at least two councillors present	Ensure emergency contact numbers available; first aid provision considered for events involving ladder use	Councillors	On day
Working near live carriageway	Councillors / public	Hi-vis clothing; awareness of traffic	Position vehicle safely; avoid standing in carriageway; maintain clear separation from traffic	Councillors	On day
Equipment failure or instability	Councillors / public	Visual check of SID unit and mounting system	Do not install if equipment is damaged or insecure; report defects immediately	Councillors / Clerk	Ongoing
